## WHAT SHOULD MY CHILD WEAR TO HURON VALLEY CATHOLIC PRESCHOOL?

Grades K-8 has a dress code. The Preschool does not follow that dress code. Our guidelines for preschoolers are listed below. If you have any questions, please call (734) 483-0366.

1. We ask that preschoolers clothing be neat and clean.
2. Clothing should be comfortable and easily laundered as we learn and play with messy things. We will be outdoors daily, in the sandbox, painting (with paint smocks), etc.
3. It is important for preschoolers to wear clothing that is easy for them to manage when using the bathroom.
4. Since we run, jump, climb, etc., we ask that children wear only closed toed shoes that do not slip on their feet. For safety reasons we ask that children do not wear "Crocs", flip flops, or open-back footwear.
5. We will be using the school's gym. It is a great indoor large muscle space. Like many newer gyms, the floor requires non-marking soles on shoes.
6. Since preschoolers often aren't sure which outerwear belongs to them when it is hanging with all their classmates belongings, please put your child's name in all outdoor wear.
